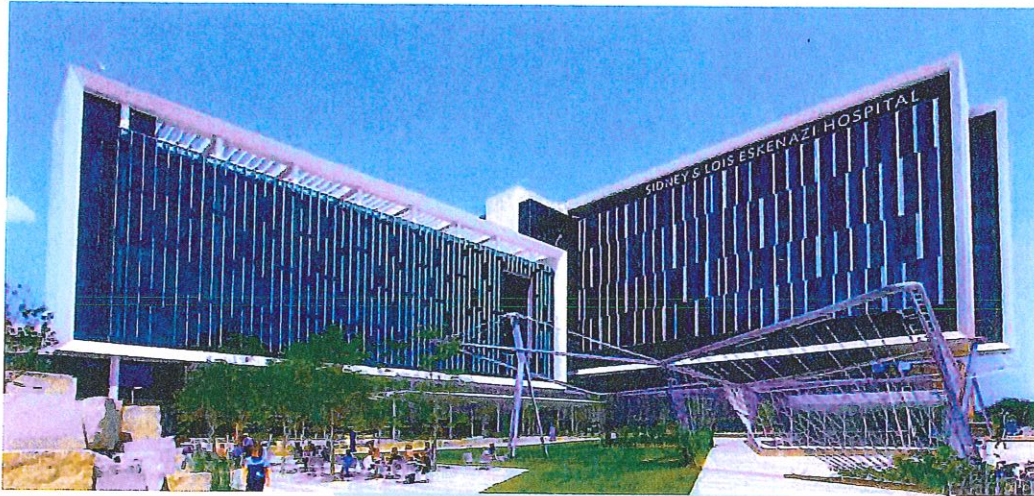

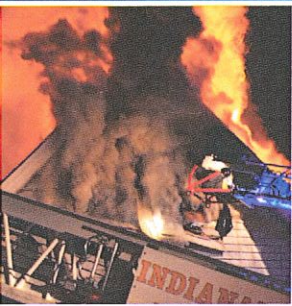

The Richard M. Fairbanks Burn Center at Eskenazi Health, located on the fourth floor of the Sidney & Lois Eskenazi Hospital in downtown Indianapolis, includes:

- 15 private beds
- 10 clinic rooms
- Two burn operation rooms
- A medical spa
- A physical therapy gym
- The most technologically advanced equipment to treat all burn injuries, including state-of-the-art laser therapy services.

The majority of communities throughout Indiana send their most severely burned patients to this facility because of its outstanding reputation and central geographic location.

Each year, the Richard M. Fairbanks Burn Center treats more than 350 inpatients and receives more than 3,700 outpatient visits.

## BURN SURVIVOR SUPPORT

The Richard M. Fairbanks Burn Center provides several support services for burn survivors and their families. Survivors Offering Assistance in Recovery (S.O.A.R.), a national program developed by the Phoenix Society, utilizes peer supporters (former patients) to assist burn patients and families in coping with and adapting to a burn injury.

The Richard M. Fairbanks Burn Center also offers a monthly support group luncheon for burn survivors, providing a chance to share experiences and both give and receive emotional support.
